Medication Procedure

Basic Medication List

In case the Student is feeling unwell, a member of CREALEARN staff is authorized to administer the following medication:

1. Bisolvon (for mild coughs);
2. Aerius (to relieve symptoms of mild allergies, such as fever);
3. Strepsils (for sore throat relief);
4. Paracetamol (for pain relief and fever reduction);
5. Ibuprofen (for pain relief and fever reduction);
6. Rennie (for heartburn and indigestion);
7. Vibrocil (decongestant for colds / congestion).

If the Parent/Guardian does not authorise the Student to receive any of this medication by a member of CREALEARN staff, the Parent/Guardian can “opt out” by sending an email to admin@creativelisboa.pt with the email subject “Basic Medication List”.

Other medication

CREALEARN's staff members will not prescribe, recommend, store or dispense beyond-basic medication for or belonging to the Student as they are not authorised or qualified to do so. Parents/Guardians are responsible for ensuring that the Student has a supply of medication sufficient to last their entire stay with CREALEARN, regardless of the nature of this medication. Therefore, the Student is responsible for keeping their beyond-basic medication with them at all times and taking the correct dosage at the correct times.
